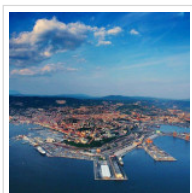

THE HUNGARIAN GOVERNMENT SIGNS THE CLOSING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PORT OF TRIESTE. 100 MILLION EURO PROJECT



The port of Trieste The agreement stipulating the investment by the Hungarian public company Adria Port zrt for the development of the port of Trieste has been closed. The Italian companies Teseco and Seastock sold the 320,000 m2 area located in Noghère in the Port of Trieste, the so-called 'ex Aquila' area. [Masotti Cassella](#) joined the Hungarian government in closing the agreement. The sellers were assisted as regards Seastok by the internal lawyer and by Lexint, and for Teseco by the BP Legal firm and the Vietti and associates firm (see the press release here).
